

THE PROBLEM

How can libraries rapidly adapt to supporting 95% of course sections online when most publishers won't sell us digital textbooks?

TEXTBOOK COSTS ARE A MAJOR EQUITY AND ACCESS CONCERN.





Broad outreach on Affordable Learning
Solutions prevented overwhelmed faculty from adopting expensive "courses in a box" for teaching online, very slightly increasing zero-cost sections.




